Private Lesson on Motorcycle or Scooter: Enjoy personalized instruction to learn motorcycle controls, slow speed riding maneuvers under the guidance of a DMV-certified instructor.

Eligibility: Valid NYS Motorcycle Permit

MSF Basic RiderCourse: The alternative to the DMV road-test as a method to learn how to ride and be tested in one course. The state benefits include the NYS Road Test Waiver the day you successfully complete the course. ****Check with insurance company to see whether they will give an insurance discount.**

Fees: Harlem River Yards-\$350; Ulster Community College- \$275

Hours: 2 ½ Day Course: 5.30pm-9pm; 7:30am-4:30pm; 7:30am-1pm (consecutive days only: Starts Mon, Wed, Fri)
2 Day Course: 7:30am-6pm Both Days (consecutive days only: Starts Tues, Thurs, Sat)

Locations: **Harlem River Yards** (Mott Haven, Bronx) & **Ulster Community College** (Stone Ridge, NY)

Eligibility: Valid New York State Drivers License & Motorcycle Permit

Be able to ride a bicycle

Full attendance for the entire course

Successfully pass a written knowledge test

Successfully pass a riding skill evaluation

Be 16 years of age or older (parental permission is required between 16 and 18 years)

Topics: In the classroom: choosing protective gear, riding in traffic, and the affect drugs and alcohol have on your riding ability. On the range: straight-line riding, turning, shifting and stopping, also progress to cornering, swerving and emergency braking. The course concludes with a knowledge test and a skill test. If you fail either the written test or the skill evaluation, (or both) you have thirty days from the original class date to take a retest free of charge. *We highly recommend taking a private lesson prior to your course. If in any event, you are unable to meet the objectives of the course, you will be counseled out and will have to re-enroll and pay for another course. Sponsored by Motorcycle Safety Foundation.*

MSF Intermediate RiderCourse: The six-hour MSF Intermediate RiderCourse is specifically designed as an interactive learning experience for riders who want to refresh their motorcycle riding skills or gain more practice after taking the Basic RiderCourse. MSS provides the motorcycles so that you can practice your skills before hitting the road.

Fee: \$150

Location: Ulster Community College (Stone Ridge, NY)

Eligibility: Possess a current and valid Motorcycle Permit (recommended for BRC graduates).

MSF Experienced RiderCourse: The six and a half-hour MSF Experienced RiderCourse is designed for riders who want to learn and refine their motorcycle riding skills. Use your own motorcycle and even receive an insurance discount (*confirm with insurance company).

Fee: \$120 (includes passenger), call office for group rate

Location: Ulster Community College (Stone Ridge, NY)

Eligibility: Possess a current and valid Motorcycle License and a street-legal, registered and inspected motorcycle.

DMV Road Test On Motorcycle or Scooter: Schedule a DMV road test to become a licensed rider.

Fees: **DMV Road Test:** Includes MSS bike or scooter, car, instructor and 30 min warm up lesson (\$200);

DMV Retest: Includes MSS bike or scooter, car & instructor (\$100)

CANCELLATION AND REFUND POLICY

I understand and agree that in order to receive a full refund (minus a \$25 processing fee) I must give the Motorcycle Safety School a minimum of 10 days cancellation or reschedule notification prior to the course start date. I understand and agree that if I cancel within (10) days and more than 24 hours of my scheduled course date I will forfeit \$125 for the MSF Basic RiderCourse, \$60 for the Experienced Rider Course, and \$75 for the Intermediate Rider Course. I understand and agree that if I cancel within (7) days and more than 24 hours of my scheduled DMV date I will forfeit \$100. I understand and agree that if I reschedule within (10) days and more than 24 hours of my scheduled course date I will have to pay an additional \$100 for the MSF Basic RiderCourse, \$33 for the Experienced Rider Course, and \$42 for the Intermediate Rider Course. I understand and agree that if I reschedule within (7) days and more than 24 hours of my scheduled DMV date I will have to pay an additional \$56. I understand and agree that if I need to cancel or reschedule my private lesson, I must give 24 hours notice for lessons during the week and 48 hours notice for lessons on the weekend, or forfeit the entire fee. I understand that if I cancel or need to reschedule less than 24 hours of the start date of any scheduled service I will forfeit the entire fee. I understand and agree that if I fail to attend any of my course sessions once the course begins, I will forfeit the entire course fee and that no refunds or make-up classes will be given if I fail to meet the attendance requirements. The Motorcycle Safety School does not have a minimum height requirement, but you must be able to touch the ground with both feet while straddling the motorcycle. Therefore, it is highly recommended that students less than 5ft tall take a private lesson or call the office at 718-599-1079 to schedule an appointment for a sit down on the motorcycle before the Basic RiderCourse. It is understood and agreed that if I fail to take a private lesson or schedule a sit down before the course starts, there will be no refund or rescheduling and the cancellation policy will apply. It is understood and agreed that I must attend ALL sessions of the course with no exceptions. I understand and agree that I must allow additional time in my course scheduling for the possibility of inclement weather conditions for motorcycle riding or extended learning time. I understand and agree that should I fail to provide my own motorcycle riding gear as follows: over the ankle boots; long pants; long sleeved shirt or jacket and full fingered gloves, I will not be permitted to participate in the course and subject to forfeiture of all course fees. I understand and agree that there is a possibility I may be counseled out of the class because I may not be able to achieve the objectives of the range exercises within the allotted time if this should occur, as per the MSF Guide Regulations I must repeat all of the range exercises beginning with #1 and I forfeit the remainder of the course fee. I understand and agree if I fail to abide by course safety and instructional guidelines as set forth by the Instructors I may be counseled out. If this should occur I forfeit the remainder of the course fee. I understand and agree that this application is NON-TRANSFERABLE. I understand and agree that the refund and cancellation policy is the sole responsibility of the Motorcycle Safety School, Inc. I understand and agree that if there are less than twelve (12) students registered for any given class, the Motorcycle Safety School has the right to reschedule. I understand and agree that I will receive the DMV Road Test Waiver on the day I complete and pass the Basic RiderCourse, unless unforeseen circumstances arise where instructors may not be able to issue the waiver. I understand and agree that all credits expire at the end of the current training season and no credits will be carried over to the next year. I understand and agree that any MSS service may be cancelled at anytime due to a conflict in the service schedule. **Cancellation via Email:** Students may cancel a service via email. If cancelling by email the student must call the office at 718-599-1079, if they have not received a confirmation of the cancellation within 48hours. ******Students are only considered cancelled from a service when they have a confirmation.*

Directions

Mott Haven, Bronx: *1 Alexander Ave (Enter on 132nd St. and Alexander Ave - Past Road Closed Sign) Bronx, NY, 10454*

Parking: When entering property drive past the road closed sign and red security booth. Park on the right hand side, on gravel area. Classroom will be on your left hand side inside grey trailer. (If the gate is closed, flash your headlights and the security guard will open the electric gate, or you can park on the street & use the pedestrian walkway).

From points North (Yonkers, Westchester): Take I-87 South towards the Triboro Bridge – Take Exit #2, in the Bronx not Yonkers, Willis Ave/3rd Ave Bridge. Turn slight right onto E134th Street. Turn right onto Bruckner Blvd (McDonalds will be on the right hand side). Go to the left lane. At first traffic light turn left onto Alexander Avenue - the dead end at 132nd Street and the Harlem River Yard entrance. You will see the MSS banner on the gate. Drive past the red security booth and park on the left next to the "Learn to Ride Here" sign, outside of the fence. You can double park cars here, do not park on the train tracks. If there is no room, make a left on the road, and park on the left side of the street. Meet in the grey classroom is next to the fence on your left side of the property.

From points South (Brooklyn, Queens): Take Triboro Bridge. Take left exit #47 onto I-87 (Deegan Expwy) North toward Albany – go 0.4 miles. Take Exit #2, Willis Ave/Third Avenue BR. Go straight on 135th St. Turn left at the 2nd traffic light onto Alexander Avenue – go 3 blocks to the dead end at 132nd St and the Harlem River Yards entrance. Drive past the red security booth and park on the left next to the "Learn to Ride Here" sign, outside of the fence. You can double park cars here, do not park on the train tracks. If there is no room, make a left on the road, and park on the left side of the street. Meet in the grey classroom next to the fence on left side of property.

From Manhattan: Take the FDR Drive North to Exit #18/Willis Avenue Bridge, Turn slight right on Willis Avenue Bridge. Go over bridge and take Bruckner Expy east/Bruckner Blvd exit. Turn left onto Bruckner Blvd. At the second traffic light, make a left onto Alexander Ave. Go to the dead end at 132nd St and the Harlem River Yards entrance. Drive past the red security booth and park on the left, outside of the fence. The grey classroom is next to the fence on your left side of the property.

Public Transportation: Take MTA #6 Train to the 3 Avenue – 138 Street stop. Walk towards the church steeple (East) to 138th St. Turn right onto Alexander Avenue. Walk 5 blocks to the end of the street to the dead end at 132nd St and the Harlem River Yards entrance. Walk past the red security booth. The grey classroom is next to the fence on your left side of the property.

Brooklyn: *809 Metropolitan Ave Brooklyn, NY 11211*

By Car: From South Brooklyn: Take the Brooklyn Queens Expressway (BQE) North to Exit 32 – Metropolitan Avenue. Make right at light onto Metropolitan Avenue. The office is at 809 Metropolitan Avenue, on the left hand side.

From Queens: Take the Brooklyn Queens Expressway (BQE) to the Meeker Avenue exit – Exit 34, towards Morgan Avenue. Keep left at the fork in the ramp. Make a left onto Morgan Avenue, proceed to Metropolitan Avenue. Make a right on Metropolitan Avenue. Go past two traffic lights. The office is located on the corner of Bushwick Avenue and Metropolitan Avenue, on the right hand side (across from the Hess gas station).

Public Transportation: "L" train to Graham Ave, Exit left stairwell, then walk 2 blocks to Metropolitan Ave & Bushwick Ave (across from Hess)

Ulster Community College: *Cottkill Road (Senate Gym, Room 135) Stone Ridge, NY, 12484*

From points North/South: From NY Thruway Exit 19 - Route 28. Bear right on Route 28 for 3/4 mile. Take exit for Route 209 South (Ellenville). Travel 209 South for 8 miles to first traffic light. Turn left on Cottkill Rd. Go about 1 mile. The college is on the right.

DMV Location: *Red Hook, Brooklyn-Located on 830 Henry Street -- Between Bay Street and Lorraine Street Red Hook, 11231*

By Car: Take the BQE and get off at the Hamilton Ave exit. Make a right on Clinton, a right on Lorraine and a left on Henry. Road Test area is between Bay and Lorraine Sts. **The DMV testing site may be subject to a last minute location change. If MSS instructor is not at the first location, please meet a block over, at the corner of Bay and Clinton St.**

Public Transportation: Take the F or G train to "Smith – 9 Sts". Exit near intersection of 9th and Smith Street. Start out going South on Smith towards Garnet Street. Turn right onto Lorraine Street and make a left onto Henry Street.

Long Island – Cross Bay Honda: *1747 Sunrise Highway, Bay Shore, NY 11706 (Cross Bay Motorsports Dealership)*

Bayshore merchandise/riding gear is purchased directly from the dealership and is subject to their own prices

From points North: Head south on Sunken Meadow Pkwy S. Continue on Sagtikos State Pkwy S. Take exit 40 & 41S toward Bay Shore/Bay Shore Rd. Merge onto Bay Shore Rd/County Rte 57. At the traffic circle, take the 1st exit onto County Rte 57/S Sunrise Hwy Service Rd. Take the ramp onto Brentwood Rd. Take the ramp onto Sunrise Hwy/N Sunrise Hwy Service Road. Destination will be on the right.

From points South: Head north on Robert Moses Causeway N. Take Exit RM1E toward Montauk/State Hwy 27 E. Merge onto Sunrise Hwy/S Sunrise Hwy Service Rd. Take the ramp on the left onto RT-27 E. Take Exit 44 toward Brentwood Rd. Merge onto Sunrise Hwy/S Sunrise Hwy Service Rd/Sunrise Hwy South Service Road. Take the ramp onto Brentwood Rd. Take the ramp onto Sunrise Hwy/N Sunrise Hwy Service Rd. Destination will be on the right.

From points West: Take I-278 E to Exit 35 to merge onto I-495 E. Take Exit 53 toward Bay Shore/SAGTIKOS Pkwy/Kings Park. Keep right at the fork to continue toward Sagtikos State Pkwy S and merge onto Sagtikos State Pkwy S. Take exit 40 & 41S toward Bay Shore/Bay Shore Rd. Merge onto Bay Shore Rd/County Rte 57. At the traffic circle, take the 1st exit onto County Rte 57/SunriseHwy/S Sunrise Hwy Service Rd. Turn right at 2nd Ave, destination will be on the left.

From points East: Head southwest on RT-27 W. Take exit 44 North toward Brentwood/Bay Shore/ Brentwood Rd. Merge onto Sunrise Hwy/N Sunrise Hwy Service Rd. Destination will be on the right.
